

UCF Multidisciplinary Doctoral Fellowship

The UCF Multidisciplinary Doctoral Fellowship is a competitive university wide program that awards one fellowship annually to an outstanding doctoral student engaged in innovative multidisciplinary research. The purpose of the fellowship is to allow the pursuit of research questions that cross traditional disciplinary boundaries. This award is intended for students who have completed at least the first year of their doctoral program and who have not yet advanced to candidacy.

Fellowship Details:

The UCF Multidisciplinary Doctoral Fellowship provides a stipend of \$20,000 (\$10,000 in Fall and Spring), tuition support (not including fees), and health insurance each year for up to three years. It is expected that students will enroll full-time during the duration of the fellowship.

Nomination Deadline:

Submission to the College of Graduate Studies at gradfellowship@ucf.edu: April 1

Fellowship begins: Fall

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for consideration for the UCF Multidisciplinary Doctoral Fellowship, the nominee must meet the following requirements:

- A doctoral student in good academic standing
- Must have completed at least the first year of the doctoral program (minimum of 18 hours) prior to the start of the fellowship
- · Cannot be advanced to candidacy
- Students supported on university fellowships or certain external fellowships (NSF Graduate Research Fellowships, NASA Fellowships, etc.) are not eligible
- Students holding this award cannot have concurrent full-time employment

Fellowship Application:

- 250-word description of prior research experience and accomplishments
- One page research proposal describing your dissertation research and highlighting the multidisciplinary nature of the research (citation sources may be additional)
- Resume or curriculum vitae (CV)
- Two letters of support from faculty from different disciplines
- Student application submission: email the application as a single file to your Program Director
- Program Director review and endorsement of application submission: nominations should be submitted electronically to gradfellowship@ucf.edu.

When submitting the nomination to gradfellowship@ucf.edu, please provide:

- The student's name and UCFID
- Application materials submitted as a single file
