Eligibility Requirements:

Previous academic record and leadership qualities will be used as selection criteria, in addition to the requirements below.

- Applicant must be a degree-seeking full-time or part-time female graduate student.
- · Applicant must have an undergraduate degree from a Florida undergraduate university.
- Applicant must have graduated from a Florida high school.
- · Applicant must be considered an emerging leader by faculty and colleagues in her field of study.
- Award recipient may be asked to speak at an Athena International event.

To apply, applicants should submit this form, along with the following documents to the UCF College of Graduate Studies:

- Personal statement addressing your background and goals.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- A resume.
