

UCF Graduate FAMU Feeder Fellowship

UCF offers Graduate FAMU Feeder Fellowships to provide financial support to the most outstanding FAMU Feeder Scholars who are admitted to UCF graduate programs. In addition to tuition and health insurance coverage, this fellowship pays a yearly stipend of \$10,000 for two years for master's students and \$12,000 for four years for doctoral students. Award recipients are selected in spring by the UCF Diversity Fellowship Committee for awards beginning the following fall term. Students may apply by completing a Graduate FAMU Fellowship application (attached or available at graduate.ucf.edu/fellowships/).

Duration of Award:

Maximum of two years of support for master's students.

Maximum of four years of support for doctoral students.

Yearly Fellowship Stipend:

\$10,000 master's; \$12,000 doctoral (paid in fall and spring semesters)

Tuition Support:

UCF College of Graduate Studies pays the charges for degree program hours during each year of the award. The student is responsible for the payment of fees (health fee, athletic fee, building fee, etc.).

Health Insurance:

A UCF Student Health Insurance Policy through UnitedHealthcare and serviced by Gallagher Student Health & Special Risk will be provided for your individual coverage for the duration of the award.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria:

- Available only to FAMU Feeder Scholars who have completed their FAMU degree within the last three semesters of their entry into a UCF graduate program.
- Admission into a UCF master's, specialist, or doctoral program
- An outstanding GRE score relative to other students admitted into your graduate degree program
- Complete fellowship application, including application form, personal statement, resumé, and two letters of recommendation.
- Full-time enrollment in an eligible graduate program is required. Please see the Financial Information section of the current Graduate Catalog for more information.

The UCF Graduate FAMU Feeder Fellowship is a competitive fellowship offered by UCF to the most outstanding FAMU Feeder Scholars who are admitted to UCF graduate programs.

Duration of Award:

Maximum of two years of support (paid in fall and spring semesters) for master's students. Maximum of four years of support (paid in fall and spring semesters) for doctoral students.

Fellowship Stipend:

\$10,000 per year for master's students; \$12,000 per year for doctoral students.

Tuition Support:

UCF College of Graduate Studies pays the charges for degree program hours during each year of the award. The student is responsible for the payment of fees (health fee, athletic fee, building fee, etc.).

Health Insurance:

A UCF Student Health Insurance Policy through UnitedHeathcare and serviced by Gallagher Student Health will be provided for your individual coverage for the duration of the award.

Please submit the following documents with this fellowship application. If you submitted your personal statement, resume, and recommendation letters that meet the criteria below as part of your admissions application, you are not required to include them with this application. A complete admissions application must be submitted by the priority deadline, January 15, to be considered for this fellowship.

- Personal statement should address your background and goals for pursuing graduate study.
- Two letters of recommendation should be from your faculty.
- · Resumé highlighting professional and academic achievements.
