The Athena International Emerging Women Leader Fellowship is awarded by Athena International. The award provides a stipend of \$2,500 to a full-time or part-time female graduate student with a strong academic record and leadership qualities.

Eligibility Requirements:

Previous academic record and leadership qualities will be used as selection criteria, in addition to the requirements below.

- Applicant must be a degree-seeking full-time or part-time graduate student.
- Applicant must have an undergraduate degree from a Florida undergraduate university.
- Applicant must have graduated from a Florida high school.
- Applicant must be considered an emerging leader by faculty and colleagues in her field of study.
- Preference will be given to an applicant who has demonstrated a commitment to advancing women in leadership in the form of volunteerism, community service or mentorship. This may be demonstrated by a brief essay or shown on a resume.

- Two letters of recommendation.
- A resume.
