

Short Term Postdoc Support (STePS)

To sustain our preeminence goals, the UCF Office of Postdoctoral Affairs (OPA) has allocated funding to support recent UCF PhD graduates through a new short term post-graduation program. The term of support is six (6) months. This is meant to be short term support only, during which time the scholar will make arrangements for post-UCF employment while receiving the benefit of mentorship by a UCF faculty member. Once the STePS support ends, a faculty member may keep the postdoc employed, but P3 funding would not be available. (see below)

PIs will cover approximately the first two months of salary + fringe and the Office of Postdoctoral Affairs will cover the latter four months. At a minimum annual rate of \$55,000, the six-month breakdown (including fringe) is PI: \$10,000 (Approximate total buy-in), OPA: \$23,825. (If a PI chooses to pay abve the minimum salary, or extend the contract beyond the six-month period, the PI will absorb the difference.)

Funding will be awarded on a first come, first served basis, one award per PI (unless funding is still available).

Please note: A postdoc may not receive both STePS funding and P3 funding--only one or the other. Note the benefits and costs of both programs and choose the one that best aligns with you and your scholar's situation.

Eligibility

To be eligible for 2024 STePS funding, a student must be a spring, summer, or fall 2024 graduate, **fully** hired as a postdoc, and eligible to lawfully work in the US on or before the **December 16, 2024 cutoff**. (see below)

OPT: Students on an F-1 visa must apply for OPT 60-90 days in advance of their hire date to ensure **physical possession** of the EAD card, which is **required** to begin working post-graduation.

If the graduating student needs a foreign screening, as required by <u>Florida Statute 1010.35</u>, we recommend requesting this **60 days** before graduation. Placement into the postdoc position cannot occur until this is completed. No exceptions.
