### Graduate Certificates in Gender Studies and Destination Marketing and Management

You may take no more than FIVE courses in a single college or discipline unless specifically approved by your advisor. If you want to earn the certificates, you must apply to each certificate program as well as the MA/MS IDS, and you will be responsible for ensuring you complete all certificate and master’s degree requirements as shown in the catalog and handbooks. Highlighted courses may be substituted for the IDS core **research** course if approved. Most courses will count as the required critical thinking and writing course for non-thesis students.
