- ✓ Currently enrolled UCF graduate student in good academic standing
- ✓ Served as a GTA (Instructor of Record) in at least one GEP course
- ✓ Taught at least two full semesters
- ✓ Completed required FCTL GTA training (online and in person)
- ✓ Attended two GEP GTA PD sessions in the application year (see below)
